Depending on the severity of the fire hazard, a fire ban may include fires contained in fire facilities in design and recreation areas. Citronella candles and torches may also be prohibited during a fire ban. Gas-and liquid-fuelled cooking stoves are normally permitted during fire bans for cooking purposes only.
